Course objectives Professional practice should facilitate the student's transition from academic education to professional work. The goal of professional practice is for the student to get closer to his future profession through practical work. The student thus gets the opportunity to apply the knowledge and abilities he gained by studying theory, and by creating different types of applications, in practice. In doing so, he should gain insight into technical, organizational, economic and social developments and their mutual connection in companies.		
Learning outcomes Training students to apply previously acquired theoretical and professional knowledge to solve specific practical problems in the field of information technology within the chosen company or institution. Acquaintance of the student with the activities of the chosen company or institution, the way of doing business, management and the place and role of employees in the IT sector in their organizational structures.		
Content of the course Each candidate individually chooses a company or institution where he will do his professional practice. In agreement with the manager or responsible person in the company/institution, and in accordance with the needs of the profession for which the student is trained, the content of professional practice is defined. The professional practice program should be in accordance with the set educational goals defined by the study program.

Teaching methods After enrolling in the appropriate semester, in which the implementation of the professional practice is foreseen, the student reports to the manager of the professional practice to perform the practice. In his application, he states the area in which he wants to do professional practice. Along with the application, he also submits an application for professional practice. Professional practice lasts at least 90 hours. The schedule is made according to the agreement of the supervisor of the professional practice and the mentor in the institution where the professional practice is implemented. Professional practice can be implemented continuously during each week of the semester in which it is scheduled or in a block, according to the contract with the institution, and in accordance with the plan for the realization of professional practice. The student writes a professional practice diary in which he describes the activities and jobs he performed during the professional practice. The head of professional practice examines and certifies the students' practice diary, i.e. checks the student's knowledge through the defense of a seminar paper or in another way if this is provided for in the study program.
